

Using the standard school Rubric

All staff now have access to the STANDARD SET RUBRIC in Turnitin, this will replace the feedback form students used to attach to their submissions. To attach the Rubric to your submission points. This document will show you how to attach it and the mark against it.

Step 1 – Attaching the STANDARD SET RUBRIC

Few errors; Citation and referencing relevant and mostly accurate. Specifications of assessment adhered to.

C
Good/Competent - 50% - 59% Occasional errors, minor inaccuracies or inconsistencies in citation.

D
Satisfactory - 40% - 49% Some minor inaccuracies and/or misunderstandings and/poor standard of presentation and not completely focused.

E
Marginal/Weak Fail - 30% - 39% Some significant inaccuracies and/or misunderstandings; poor standard of presentation; deviations to the specification of the assessment task e.g substantial deviations from the word limit and/or minor elements of the work missing; referencing inaccurate or inconsistent.

F
Very Weak Fail - <30% Several significant
