




Have you taken an active role during ward rounds as a student or as part of your routine work?



If yes, how many times?




Do you feel that medication and prescribing errors could be avoided by pharmacists attending ward rounds routinely?





Please indicate your current confidence level in playing an active role during ward rounds (1=not confident, 5=very confident)

POST-Training






How valuable do you feel it would be to attend rounds routinely as part of your work? (1=not valuable-5=very valuable)



Comment: However, takes too much time, not always staffing and coordinator usually attends and passes on info or info in medical notes


POST-Training





How would you rate this session? (1=poor, 5=excellent)




How could this session be improved?

- Couple days session


Do you feel a safety checklist increases confidence on the ward round?


Would you benefit from further teaching sessions relating to ward rounds?
