At Risk of Autoimmune Diabetes



We would like to tell you all about a research study to help you to decide whether you want to be a part of it.

- The ARAD study is for children who may get type 1 diabetes, to stop them feeling very unwell.
- If you decide you would like to help this study, we will ask for a very small blood sample from your finger and a swab sample from inside your cheek.
- We will test the samples in our laboratory.
- We will send the results from the blood sample to you and your family.
- We will be in touch with you and your family each year.

What is Type 1 Diabetes?

- Type 1 diabetes happens when there is not enough insulin in your body.
- Insulin is what our body needs to get energy from the food we eat to give your body energy to run and do the things you want to do. Without insulin, people become very unwell.
- With your help we want less people to have type 1 diabetes in the future.

What is ARAD testing for?

- ARAD is testing children to see if they might develop type 1 diabetes.
- We are looking for autoantibodies which are protein markers found in the blood.
- We would also like to test samples of your urine and stool for other information that may help us understand what is happening in the body.

What would I need to do in the ARAD Study?

- We would like to look at your blood when you join and then once a year.
- We can send you a kit in the post for collecting blood from your finger at home. Your family can help you do this, and your finger will only be sore for a moment.
- We will ask your parent/guardian for some details about you, such as your name and age.
- We will also ask you to collect urine and stool samples, but you can say no to giving samples at any time.

Why is ARAD important?

- We want to help children who may get type 1 diabetes early before they become too unwell.
- Taking part in ARAD means you are helping us find out why people get type 1 diabetes and how we can stop it happening.
