

BBSRC CASE Placement Report for PhD Students

A key component of the BBSRC CASE Studentship programme is the requirement to spend a minimum of three months on placement with the non-academic partner.

The aim of this report is to capture information on the CASE placement, including the major achievements arising from the placement. The report also aims to capture the extent to which the CASE placement gave the student the opportunity to develop their skills.

The information provided in the report will be collated and made non-attributable. Supervisors and host institutions will not be able to view the response however aggregated analyses will be used for BBSRC monitoring purposes and may be shared with host institutions and academic partners.
