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

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## What is the Jisc student digital experience insights survey?



- Asks students across higher (HE) and further education (FE) about their attitudes to digital, as well as their experiences of digital in their organisation and on their course
- For 2021-22 there were 33,691 responses from UK HE students
- This presentation summarises some key questions and compares it to the benchmark and last 3 years
- Report with all findings will be shared in Autumn

## Our student sample


We asked 19,975 students at all levels of studies

One link was shared on multiple different student facing platforms to try and reach as many students as possible

**245 of our students responded to the insights survey (1% response rate)** 

Whenever students were asked how much they agree with a statement they could answer either agree, neutral, or disagree

Students could choose to skip any of the questions


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
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
## How does City's data compare to the benchmark over the last **3 years?**

## **Overall how would you rate the quality of online learning on your course?**


