1. Apologies for absence

3. Matters Arising
  - HMO Regulations: NM has sent email to council contact but has bounced back.
  - To Let Posters in windows: some small ones are appearing. Councillor Lucinda Preston has asked us to take photos for evidence
  - Speed watch Update: have been awaiting repair of camera, then will put on West Parade.
  - Facebook questions: Do you live in the West End? Which street do you live on?
  - Property A - (7 Self-Contained Apartments – November 2016): will ask re parking permits for flats
  - Street closures: not allowed for West End Lights or for kids to play, unless street is dead end.
  - Property B - (Re: rubbish in skip): mention to Cllr Neil Murray about being used by 3<sup>rd</sup> party company. This would be change of use.
  - Property C - becoming a dumping ground. RL and SL have reported to PPASB.
4. Rudgard Lane development - future West Parade disruption  
Have started work again. All utilities are too small, so will have to dig up West Parade and the Avenue for three weeks, may be road or path. Will give us some notice.
5. Commons Update/Whittons Play Park  
GW going to meeting with City Hall and Commons Advisory. Horses will not be coming off.
