

1 A church dedicated to all the Saints in Lincolnshire and its tradition is orthodox

2 In 1311 this was the tallest building in the world and can be seen from all over Lincoln

3 One of only five Medieval Jewish Houses in England representing a large community in 12th and 13th centuries in Lincolnshire

4 Recently opened in this new location – here to feed and support families in Lincoln

5 A place where people worship in silence

6 Built in 1799 and dedicated to Hugh of Lincoln

7 This Community Food Waste Cafe in the heart of the city takes it's foody name from the Lane where it's located

8 Founded in 1865 by William Booth, they are known for their work with people who are struggling

9 Built in 1725 and was one of the first dissenting places of worship in Lincoln

10 A church founded on the teachings of John Wesley

11 Opened in 2018 with a green dome

12 The first Black Pentecostal Church in Lincoln
