We share power, make decisions openly and collectively, and are accountable to our co-production community.

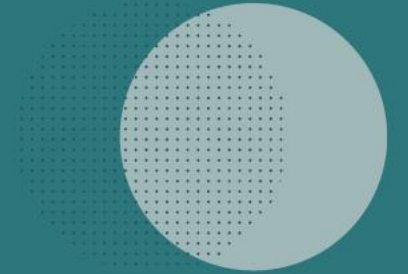


CHALLENGING

You told me it was some kind of 'shared decision', you mumbling nonsense at me like some blonde haired politician.

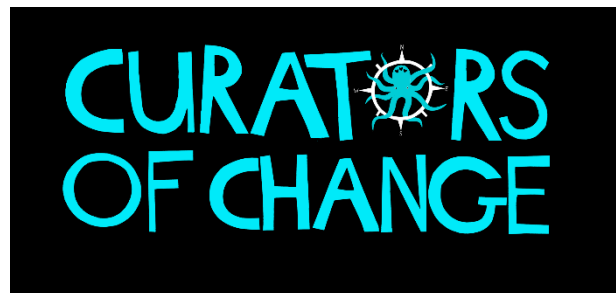
