<p>Home Learning at Moorfoot;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The aim of the activity/learning and steps to being successful will be shared within the teacher or EYP input • Feedback will be linked to success criteria • Planning will take into account previous learning and needs of pupils in order to move learning forward • New concepts will be introduced building on prior learning and will be revisited when we return to school 	<p>Pupils will be;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Given the opportunity to register/check in daily with their teacher • Given a literacy and numeracy task each day (Primary) • Given learning activities to participate in at their level • Given access to the appropriate resources electronically with the option of paper copies available to collect • Given a range of activities that they can engage with independently and with adult assistance • Able to seek help and guidance from their class teachers or keyworker • Given opportunities to share work regularly
<p>Teachers/EYPs will;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P1-7 teachers will post activities daily ready for the start of the school day including a daily check in. • ELC practitioners will post a grid of activities on a Friday afternoon for the following week • Be available to provide further instructions, feedback and advice within the school working day (08:50 – 3:15) unless they are working in school. (Responses may not be immediate but will be within a reasonable time frame) • Utilise Seesaw and Google Suite as platforms to share learning and provide feedback • Continue to use opportunities via these platforms to provide pre recorded input. Further opportunities to provide whole class meetings/ELC get-togethers will be used and developed over forthcoming weeks.
