## Home Learning Suggestions

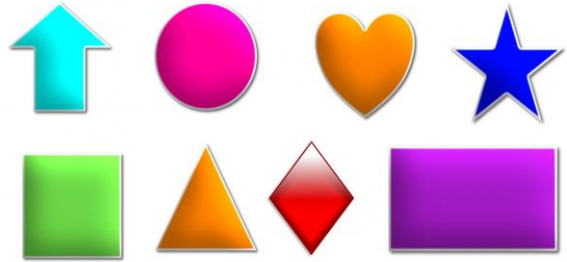
### Numeracy Activity:
