We are also working on offering face to face check ins with the class teacher throughout the week these will take place on *GOOGLE* meets and your CT will post date, time and joining instructions connected to these. Please bear with us as we develop our IT skills in order to operate these successfully. Some staff may be quicker off the mark than others as we learn this new skill.
