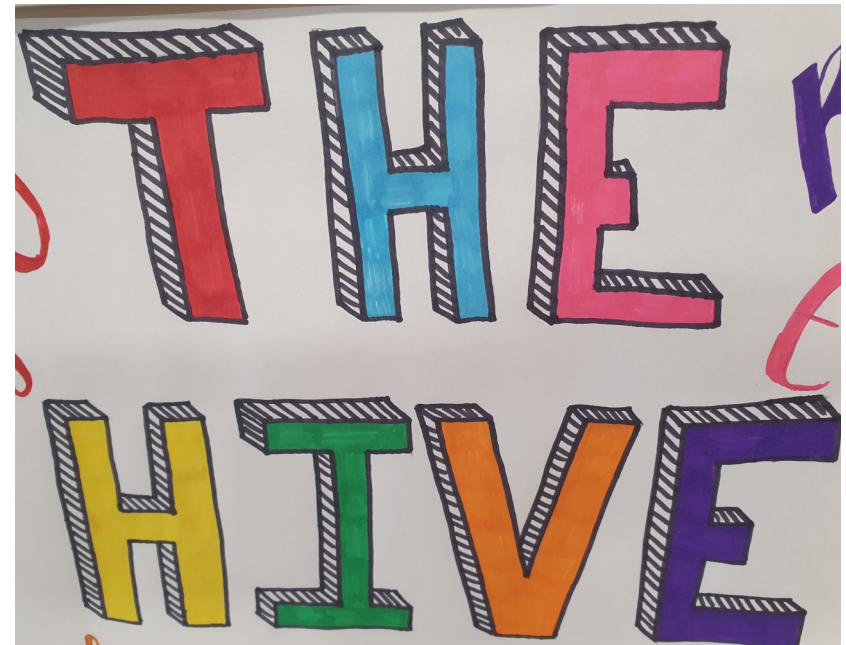

Topic/IDL

Our main topic focus is The Zones of Regulation, which is about how we deal with our emotions. This will help us to identify how we are feeling and give us some strategies on how to cope with them.

We will also be learning about a range of other mini topics that we are interested in such as food, animals, transport and other countries.

Literacy

We have been looking at different fairy tales and stories to help us settle after break and lunch, and we have also been doing some fun lessons based on this.

From Monday-Thursday we do Read Write Inc to help build our reading and writing skills and learn new sounds. We do story creating to use our imaginations to make up stories and practise writing.

Numeracy and Maths

We are learning about a range of different number work skills, some we have used before and some that are new. Each day we will do a different domain of numeracy, including: numbers, adding and subtracting, multiplying, patterns, fractions and sharing.

Our maths topic for this term is Shape and what their properties are.

Class Expectations and Rewarding Positive Behaviour

When learning in the Hive we are focusing on being safe in school. We use the same behaviour chart idea as the other classes to promote positive behaviour, when reaching the top children earn a certificate or if they are not being sensible and unsafe at the bottom their adult will be contacted.

We are continuing to use our are school Fieldies to encourage our learners to be the best they can be in all areas of life. We also have a variety of stickers used as praise for putting in effort and showing our Fieldies qualities.
