

Primary 1 Transition Events 2018



May/ June 2018

Miss Jennifer Kelly, Acting Principal Teacher will visit all nursery partners to:

- meet your child
- provide a social story about Coming to St David's for your child to share at home (please read this story with your child regularly to prepare them for their first visit)
- complete a handover of key information about your child.

Thursday 31st May 9.15-10.15am

- Primary 1 pupils will access the classroom and work with staff to complete a range of activities
- parents and carers will meet in the Hall to hear key information about the transition process, engage in table top activities and ask and answer questions.

Thursday 7th June 2.00 – 3.00pm

- Primary 1 pupils will meet with their Primary 7 Buddies (current Primary 6 pupils) and complete an activity
- parents and carers are invited to the hall to meet a range of partner agencies who work closely with the school
- Midlothian's Mobile Library visits St David's Primary fortnightly and parks up around 2.45pm. Families are invited to visit the Mobile Library after the above activities. You can join as a member and borrow books to read at home
- pupils will be given a feedback postcard after this event. Please post this back to us.

Tuesday 12th June 9.15 11.30am Enhanced Transition excursion to Weehailes Adventure Park, Musselburgh

- moving from one school to another can be a daunting process. Your child may benefit from additional support to manage this transition. If you have concerns about how your child will settle into his/ her new environment or feel your child would benefit from additional support, please speak with a member of staff at the above transition events.
- your child may be identified as benefiting from an enhanced transition by nursery staff or the team at St David's. If this is the case, we will speak with you directly. Play Therapy Base and Home Link Family Support, two of our partner agencies will support at this transition event.
