

Literacy

Primary 3 will be focussing on Listening Memory Skills to build on our Listening and Talking Skills.

Children will be learning about Making Connections and Predictions based on the books they are reading. Our class will be practising a new spelling sound each week.

We will be writing Diary Entries and Stories this term.

How can you help?

Listen to your child reading aloud, model reading aloud to them. Practise your child's weekly spelling words - shared on Seesaw. Support your child with correct formation of letters.

Numeracy and Mathematics

Primary 3 will be covering Counting Development and Place Value in Numeracy during Term 1.

We will focus on 2D and 3D Shapes during Maths.

How can you help?

Counting to and from 100.
Reading / writing numbers to 100.
Ordering numbers within 100.
Practising odd / even numbers.
