RRS - Week beginning 26th August the Article of the Week is Article 12.

Article 12 – Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously.

Medication – please ensure that you drop off any medication your child requires at the office as soon as possible. This includes inhalers and epipens that were returned to families at the end of term.

Meet the Teacher – Meet the Teacher (for parents – children welcome to attend) is scheduled for Tuesday 27th August. There will be 20 minute slots with a presentation and chance to meet your child’s new teacher. This will be 3.30-3.50pm and then 4-4.20pm. Any information shared at this event will also be shared on Seesaw for any parents unable to attend.

Primary 6 and 7 lunches – Please be reminded that school lunches for Primary 6 and Primary 7 are not free for pupils. The cost of a school lunch per day is £2.10. Payment can be made on Parent Pay. If you need login details please contact the school office.

School Photographs – sibling and individual photographs are scheduled to be taken on the 3rd of September by Coldwells Photography. Should you wish for your child’s photograph not to be taken on this day then please inform the school office beforehand. Like last year, you will receive photograph proofs in a sealed envelope and children will not know the contents in an attempt to reduce pressure on families to purchase from eager children. The school photographs taken by any company are connected to the school SEEMIS account – this is the system used by schools across Scotland to store personal data. The photographs stored on SEEMIS for Primary 7 are used to generate their Young Scot Card prior to attending High School.

Annual Data Check and local excursion permissions – Please complete and return the Annual Data Check and local excursion permission form that was sent home in a sealed envelope with your child today. *Please see the attached letter for further information about what our local excursion permission covers.*

It imperative that these forms are returned in a timely manner in order for us to ensure we have the most up-to-date information and contact details for in the case of an emergency, and also to ensure children are able to access learning opportunities in our local community. We ask that these are returned no later than *Friday 30th August* and thank you in advance for your support with this.
