Useful linking phrases: signposting.

The phrases below give some options when trying to vary the language in your work. The first section, **structural signposts**, offers useful phrases when you are indicating to your reader something about the structure or direction of your writing, and how you are going to present your ideas. The second section, **critical thinking signposts**, contains phrases that you can use to make your arguments clear to your reader, and indicate the relationship between ideas and evidence.
