The Danish Constitution

- 1849 (latest edition 1953)
- § 77**
- “Any person shall be at liberty to publish her/his ideas in print, in writing and in speech, subject to her/him being held responsible in a court of law.”
- “Censorship and other preventive measures shall never again be introduced.”

§ 77
En hvem er berettiget til på tryk, i skrift og tale at offentliggøre sine tanker, dog under ansvar for domstolene. Censur og andre forebyggende forholdsregler kan ingensinde på ny indføres.

Media Trends (in short)

- Paid newspapers: Going down, slowly disappearing
- Online subscriptions: Going up
- Free newspapers: Up -> down -> stable -> down
- Broadcast consumption (TV and Radio): Rather stable, going down
- Streaming and podcasts: Going up and up
- All media consumption: Stable and up

Status: Depression and development – focus on mobile devices, building relationships


The price reason? subscription Politiken or Jyllands-Posten 365 days: > 1000 EUR

One week peak season skiing holiday in Austrian Alps (1/2 pension): ungefähr 1000 EUR


In the newsstand: 1 issue: 30-40 DKK = 4-5 EUR

... and then: Moving from paper to web-subscriptions!






Media Trends

- All former newspaper houses are now media houses (many and multiple platforms/devices).



The Danish media has lost perspective and interest in the rest of the world

Trump's inaugural speech on January 20 has naturally made headlines in the Danish media. What is less natural is the types of headlines it has created.

We have talked a lot about Greenland and about customs duties on Danish goods. Trump touched on the punitive tariffs in his inaugural speech – not in relation to Denmark, but in relation to Europe in general. He did not mention Greenland with a word.

Still, the Danish news media were loaded with stories about Greenland that night. In TV Avisen, there were several times a switch to DR's political editor who stood – all alone – at Christiansborg, because no politicians wanted to make a statement.

TV in Denmark

- DR and TV2 are public service = they have obligations (they are also among the largest news sites)
- No national **commercial** news TV
- Local television since 1983, back then with no broadcast advertising and no networking
- Advertising permitted in 1988 (not DR)
- Big players also: for example MTG/Viasat (TV3, TV3+, etc) and Discovery Networks (Kanal 4, 5, 6, 9, etc)

TV in Denmark

- 1951: DR, Danmarks Radio (Danish Broadcasting Corp.), began transmissions
 - DR added: DR2 (1996), Update (news) (2007-2013) Ramasjang (children 3-6 years) and DR K (culture) (2009-2020), DR3 og Ultra (children 7-12 years) (2013), and more – and shifts
- 1988: TV 2 began transmissions
 - TV2 added: Zulu (2000), Charlie (2004), Film (2005-2015), News (24 hours) (2006), Fri (2013), Sport (2015), Sport X (2020)


TV in Denmark

- More channels, but rather stable consumption
- The public service TV stations - DR and TV2 - have as much as >70 percent of the total viewing.
- Streaming companies like Netflix are having significant market shares.
- **2022:** New law/ regulation forcing streaming to pay "taxes" and follow some public service requirements.

Figur 31: Public service-tv's andel (%) af det samlede tv-forbrug opdelt efter alder, 1992-2020.


